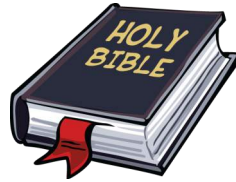

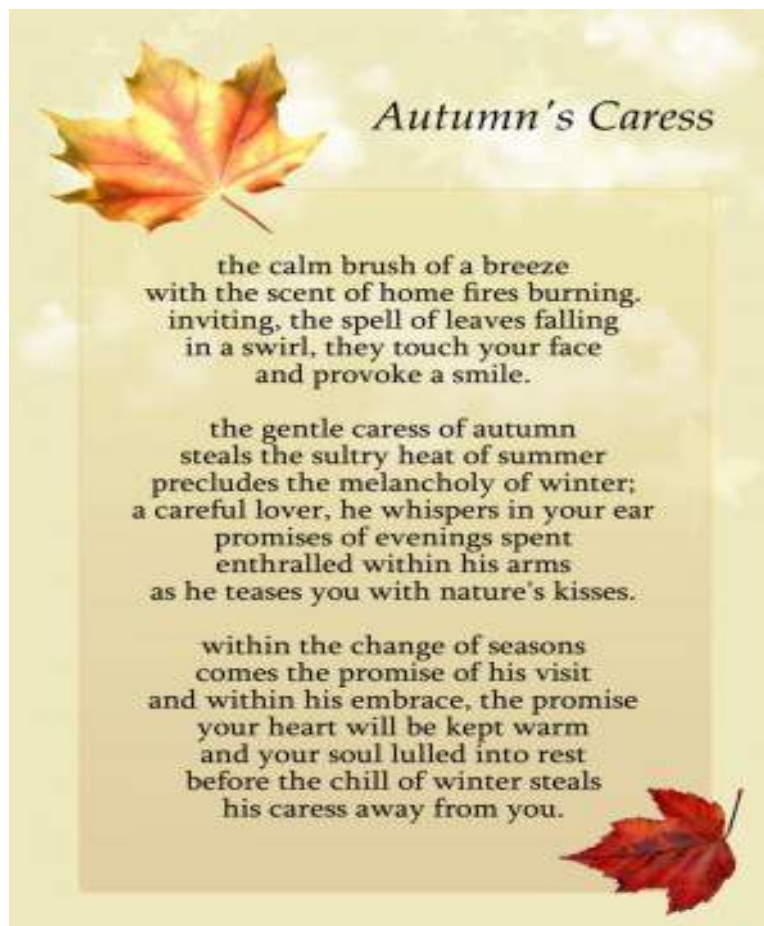


The leaves are changing

YOU MAY HAVE WONDERED: What is a Presbyterian?

Presbyterianism refers to the system of church government of the church.

The name, “Presbyterian,” refers to the system of government the church uses. The Presbyterian form of church government is government or oversight by elders elected by the congregation. Two other forms of church government are “Episcopal” and “Congregational.” In the Episcopal system, the church is governed by bishops or, in the case of the Roman Catholic church, the pope. In the Congregational system, each individual church is government by the congregation as a whole. The word “Presbyterian” comes from the Bible, from the Greek word for “elder.”

In the Presbyterian church, teaching elders (i.e., ministers) and ruling elders are selected, ordained, and responsible for their local congregation. Other business duties of the church, such as finances and buildings, are responsibilities given to deacons, who also are elected by the congregation.

The lowest “court” of the Presbyterian system is the Session which is made up of the pastor and the elders of local church. Pastors and elder representatives from a group of churches, typically in a defined geographical area, made up a “Presbytery.” A group of Presbyteries make up a Synod. In some larger Presbyterian denominations, a group of Synods make up a General Assembly. In the ARP church, there are three Synods: USA, Mexico, and Pakistan. In the USA Synod, which also includes churches in Canada, there are ten presbyteries.

The Presbyterian church follows a “confessional” tradition, meaning that believers reaffirm their faith using “confessions,” such as the Apostle’s Creed, the Nicene Creed, or another statement of faith. These confessions are found in the Book of Confessions, which contains several historical statements of what many Presbyterians believe. The Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms serve as the principle confession of the ARP Church.

Presbyterians observe two sacraments: baptism and the Lord’s Supper, believing that Jesus Christ instituted only these two sacraments. Baptism may be by sprinkling, pouring, or immersion. As the ARP Directory for Public Worship explains: “Sacraments are signs and seals of the covenant of grace. As signs, they signify (represent) the benefits promised to believers by God in His covenant of grace, and the duties required of them as members of that covenant. As seals, they confirm these promises, assuring believers that God is faithful to perform all that He has promised. They also confirm our membership in God’s covenant people and bind us to our covenant obligations.”
